Profile

I am a Colombian designer, educator and researcher. I studied Industrial Design at the Jorge Tadeo Lozano University (2008), Social Design (Master in Design) at the Design Academy of Eindhoven (2013) and successfully defended my PhD in the Arts with the Catholic University of Leuven (KU Leuven), for which I was granted a Marie-Curie research scholarship by the EU.

From the moment I began working on my bachelor's graduation project back in 2007, I have been very critical of the relation of design with the industrial-commercial circuit, to which it has been historically linked; but, at the same time, I have been constructive in exploring alternative fields of practice for designers, closer to real-life situations of diverse communities and with an explicit social innovation approach. This curiosity has led me to collaborate with local partners in specific contexts, always in the public sphere and through collective practices.

Simultaneous to my creative practice, I have always maintained a growing interest in formative processes (education), which has allowed me to take part in different academic initiatives (both formal and informal/experimental); in such cases, my goal has been to craft and propose activities and projects that support students/pupils in exploring an expanded design practice, through trans and interdiciplinary collaborations.
